How To Play

1. Dealer shuffles and deals 5 cards face down to each player. Put remaining cards face down in centre.
2. Players pick up their cards not letting others see the pictures or words.
3. Players place matching cards in front of them.
4. The dealer then asks any other player if they have a card that matches one in their hand eg "John, do you have **we**?"
5. If 'yes' the card must be handed over so the questioner can make a pair. The pair is placed down and questioner asks again.
6. If the player doesn't have the card they say 'Go Fish' and questioner picks top card from centre pile to try and make a pair. If they make a pair they ask again, if they cannot make a pair the next player has a turn.
7. If a player does not have a card on their turn they take the top card from the centre pile and ask.
8. The game continues until there are no cards left.
9. The winner is the person with the most pairs.
